Course Overview

This custom designed, advanced off-road driver training has been specifically tailored to the requirements of military and law enforcement personnel who operate in extreme terrain and remote areas with limited logistical support.

Training topics include:

- Comprehensive selection criteria, analysis, and preparation of civilian 4x4 vehicles for deployment by Mil and LE teams in remote terrain in foreign theatres of operation.
- Field expedient repair techniques and materials, repair or abandon decision matrices.
- Expedition vehicle preparation, tools and spares planning, recommended upgrades and modifications.
- Advanced off-road vehicle recovery techniques including complex winching, multi-vehicle recovery, rollover prevention, and rollover recovery methods.
