COURSE OVERVIEW

Training is specifically tailored to the requirements of military personnel who operate Armored HMMWV's and other heavy 4x4 vehicles in remote areas and harsh terrain with limited logistical support or back-up.

- VEHICLE OPERATION ON UNIMPROVED ROADS AND TRAILS. DRIVING TECHNIQUES IN VARYING TERRAIN TO INCLUDE DESERT, MUD, ROCKS, SAND, AND WATER CROSSINGS.
- SELF RECOVERY METHODS AND VEHICLE-TO-VEHICLE RECOVERY FOR MULTIPLE STUCK/DISABLED VEHICLE SCENARIOS.
- FIELD EXPEDIENT REPAIR TECHNIQUES AND MATERIALS, REPAIR OR ABANDON DECISIONS.
- ADVANCED OFF-ROAD VEHICLE RECOVERY TECHNIQUES INCLUDING COMPLEX WINCHING, MULTI-VEHICLE RECOVERY, AND ROLLOVER RECOVERY METHODS.
